RECAP: Psalm 37:4 NKJV

## WHAT DELIGHT LOOKS LIKE (Job 22:21-27 ESV)

- It looks a lot like a good relationship
  - 1. Agree with God and find peace
  - 2. Receive instruction from Him
  - 3. A good relationship builds you
  - 4. Money is not the god or the goal
- Then you will delight in the Lord
  - 1. Lift up your face to God not hiding
  - 2. Confidence in your prayers that He hears you

## A PICTURE OF DELIGHTING IN THE LORD (2 Chronicles 1:6-12 NKJV)

- Solomon loved God
  - 1. Walked in God's ways followed his father's example
  - 2. He had an appreciation for God's mercy in his life
- The desire of Solomon's heart
  - 1. Wisdom and knowledge to lead
  - 2. What Solomon requested pleased God
  - 3. God gave him the desire of his heart and more
- Delighting in the Lord is honoring the Lord with your life (Isaiah 58:13-14 NKJV)
  - 1. We don't treat the Sabbath today as different
  - 2. The principle of honoring God is still the same (Galatians 5:22-24 NKJV) (Ephesians 4:29 NKJV)
  - 3. Then after putting these principles into practice (Matthew 6:33 NKJV)

## COMMITTING YOUR WAY TO THE LORD (Psalm 37:5 NKJV)

- Trusting God with your life
  - Very similar to the prayer of consecration that Jesus prayed (Luke 22:41-42 NKJV) (Proverbs 16:3 NKJV)
