SKILLS ARE DEVELOPED IN DOING: DON'T FRET (Psalms 37:1-4 NKJV)

- Do not fret because of others
 - 1. Fret to be angry, to burn, kindled
 - 2. Can be a result of comparison
- Especially do not fret because of people doing wrong and doing well
 - 1. Too easy to see things from a limited perspective (Psalms 73:3-5 NKJV)
 - 2. And we don't know the eternal story (Psalms 37:7-10 NKJV)
 - 3. We are playing the long game (1 Peter 1:24-25 NKJV)
 - 4. There is a life to come (Proverbs 23:17-18 NKJV)

SKILL ARE DEVELOPED IN DOING: TRUST THE LORD (Psalms 37:3 NKJV)

- · A direct counter to fretting
 - 1. Don't ask yourself, tell yourself (Psalms 56:10-11 NKJV)
 - 2. Trust in the Lord will involve trust in His Word
- Trust and do good (1 Peter 2:15 NKJV)
 - 1. A counter to those who do wrong
 - 2. Doing good is much harder to oppose
- Dwell in the land
 - 1. Stay planted; don't jump around (Psalms 92:12-14 NKJV)
- Cultivate / feed on faithfulness
 - 1. Faithfulness is firmness, steadfastness
 - 2. Cultivate faithfulness in the little things (Luke 19:17 NKJV)
 - 3. Feed securely on His faithfulness (1 Corinthians 1:9 NKJV) (Psalms 119:138 NKJV)
